This letter is to advise you that there are additional deficiencies that must be addressed in determination of the final bond amount. I spoke with you on January 23, 1984 and outlined them for you. They are:


(a) (2) It is necessary that bond estimates reflect costs to the RA with respect to equipment delivery to the site, i.e., a mobilization cost. Please include this in the calculations.

The applicant must provide documentation substantiating how the number of shifts required to complete various tasks in the bond estimate were determined. Information as to how equipment productivity was determined and what haul distance was used to determine cycle time must be provided.

The applicant must provide the cost associated with riprapping the stream channel to include an estimate of the quantity of riprap required and the costs to install it.

This information must be included in the mine plan.
