Dear Mr. Braxton;

Enclosed are three (3) copies of a proposed amendment to our Gordon Creek #2 Mine Plan. This proposal consists of two changes to the #7 Mine conveyor.

- 1) To raise the tailpiece and drive at the #3 transfer approximately 24 inches, and to enclose the transfer area. This will allow for better maintenance and cleaning of this area and will eliminate concerns over contamination of the drainage by possible hydraulic leaks. The existing drainage will remain unchanged. Some additional concrete will be placed; however, the reclamation cost will be minimal and should not necessitate a change in the performance bond; and,
- 2) To "straighten" the #7 Mine conveyor at the discharge end. This will merely change the location of the #7 Mine coal stockpile. The new pile location will be in the area of the present storage shed which has been approved to be moved. This change will have a positive effect on the environment by moving the pile further away from the undisturbed diversion. No drainage changes will be made, and since the existing structures and materials will be used, no bond charge should be necessary.


It is our hope this proposed amendment will meet with your
