The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Western Field Operations (WFO), has received the June 20, 1986, Beaver Creek Coal Company's submittal of an amendment to the approved mine reclamation plan of Utah permit No. ACT/007/016 for the Gordon Creek #2 and #7 mines. This amendment addresses conditions outlined by the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining for abatement of NOV No. N86-4-2-1 regarding drainage control on the haulroad. OSMRE reviewed this submittal and has determined that it does not constitute a modification to the approved mining plan under 30 CFR 746.18.
