Re: Technical Review, MRP Amendment, Water Monitoring Plan Change, Beaver Creek Coal Company, Gordon Creek #2 & 7 Mines, ACT/007/016-86A, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has completed the review of your March 16, 1987 response to our February 3, 1987 deficiency letter for the MRP amendment referenced above. The majority of the response is acceptable. However, BCCC must commit to the monitoring program provisions as outlined in the remarks column of the Division's February 3, 1987 letter. Specifically, stations 2-2-W, 2-5-W, and 2-6-W, must be sampled as requested in the February 3, 1987 technical memo (copy of letter and memo attached). The Division will be prepared to grant final approval for this water monitoring plan change when a written commitment to this request is provided.

As a condition to issuance of final approval, the Division requests ten (10) copies of the revised water monitoring plans which are formatted to allow direct insertion as replacement pages into the approved mining and reclamation plan. The revised plans should be dated and numbered accordingly. If possible, please provide your response and these copies by May 25, 1987
