RE: Resolution of Special Conditions from OSM Permit  
UT-0010,8-84, Beaver Creek Coal Company, Gordon Creek  
#2 and 7 Mines, ACT/007/016, Folder #2, Carbon County,  
Utah

This memo is to document the resolution of four stipulations from the August 1984 OSM permit for the Beaver Creek Coal Company's Gordon Creek #2 and 7 Mines.

Condition No. 3:

This condition requiring the monitoring of in-mine inflows has been satisfied by inclusion of the monitoring commitment on page 7-53 of the recompiled mine plan.

Condition No. 4:

This condition requiring quantitative monitoring of sampling sites 2-10-W and 2-11-W is no longer applicable. Site 2-10-W is now contained in Table 7-17 (Operational Monitoring Stations) in the mine plan. Site 2-11-W has been discontinued by amendment of the approved Permit Application Package.

Condition No. 8:

Secondary mining underneath Beaver Creek has been addressed by Division approval in April 1985. Page 3-60 and 3-61 contains commitments for monitoring and mitigation required by the Division's stipulated approval.

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In conclusion, the only remaining stipulations that will be input to the state permit to be issued in the near future will be Condition No. 7 regarding mass movement, Condition No. 10 regarding powerpole raptor electrocution protection measures, Condition No. 11 regarding protection of Hedysarum occidentale var. canone, and Condition No. 12 regarding use of spoil material to backfill against highwalls.

A new stipulation will be added to the permit, which is a standard boiler plate stipulation for mitigation of subsidence induced impacts.
