SYNOPSIS:

Concerns brought up during the recent Initial Completeness Review for Gordon Creek #2, #7 and #8 Mines were addressed in the June 28, 1989 submittal. This mine reviews the submittal.

ANALYSIS:

Following is a list of regulations for which concerns were addressed in the June 28, 1989 submittal.

1. UMC 783.13: Description of Hydrology and Geology General requirements.
2. UMC 783.16: Surface Water Implementation.
3. UMC 783.18: Chronological Information.
4. UMC 784.14: Reclamation Plan: Protection of the Hydrologic Balance.

The submittal adequately addressed all problems associated with these regulations brought up during the recent Initial Completeness review.

RECOMMENDATION:

Determine the application for Gordon Creek #2, #7 and #8 Mines Five Year Permit Renewal complete.

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
