Synopsis

The applicant has submitted a response tailored to the Division's technical comments for the Five-Year Permit Renewal. This memo reviews the operator's response to those comments.

Analysis

Based on the operator's changes to Table 7-21, reducing the size of riprap required for the Lower No. 2 Mine Area and the text changes found on page 7-152 of the plan supporting this change, the operator has adequately addressed the Division's technical concerns.

The maximum diameter riprap used in the channel for the Lower No. 2 Mine Area will be three feet in diameter and the subsequent gradation is changed to match the gradation specifications found in the PAP.

One typographic error was detected on page 7-152, and the operator was informed of this error and is making the necessary change and resubmitting this page. In review of the PAP it was ascertained that the PAP was not updated with recent text and table changes. Whether this is an error on the Division's part or the operator's responsibility, Dan Guy, the operator's representative, has agreed to update the PAP.

Recommendation

The text changes mentioned to the operator be made and the PAP be updated to reflect current approved plans for reclamation.
