Re: Permit Renewal Condition #1, Part 2, Mountain Coal Company, Gordon Creek #3 & #6 Mines, ACT/007/017, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

A typographical error was found on my letter to you dated February 20, 1992. The error reads as follows:

Since the entire area had been previously mined, a reasonable goal for the operator to consider would be to achieve a 37% vegetative cover, 640 pounds per acre production and 100 shrubs per acre on the entire reclaimed area.

The statement should read 1000 shrubs per acre. This is noted in the technical memorandum dated February 20, 1992 from Susan White.

Please correct Appendix 9 to show 1000 shrubs per acre as the reclamation success standard.
