Re: Reclamation Plan - Abatement of NOV #N92-20-1-1, Mountain Coal Company, Gordon Creek #2, #7, and #8 Mine, ACT/007/016-DO-91A, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

The Division initiated the review of the reclamation only plan for the Gordon Creek #2, #7, and #8 Mines. The initial review of the hydrology portion of the reclamation plan indicated that critical information regarding design calculations for the diversions and the ponds was not submitted. Therefore, it became necessary to issue NOV #N92-20-1-1.

I have enclosed the initial hydrology review of this plan. A thorough review could not be done due to the lack of information. A totally new hydrology plan must be assembled, deleting all inappropriate information from the old plan and include all of the necessary information in a format that is easily readable.

The other disciplines have not completed their reviews, but, unfortunately, I anticipate that some of the same problems may exist.

This Division Order was issued June 6, 1991 and extensions have been granted up to now. It was agreed in a meeting held on February 25, 1992, that a complete and adequate reclamation plan would be submitted this spring so that reclamation could be done during the 1992 construction season. However, this has not occurred. Therefore, it is imperative to have a complete and adequate (and easily readable, not confusing) reclamation plan that has all of the necessary information for the entire reclamation plan be submitted to the Division by June 22, 1992 in order to abate this notice of violation.
