


I am the surface owner of the land where Mountain Coal Company's Gordon Creek Nos. 2, 7 and 8 Mines are located. I previously asked the Division to approve a change in postmining land use for this area so I can use it as a staging area for my sheep. I have spoken to Dan Guy, and he suggested that I should renew my request.

I am a stockman, and my main business is raising sheep. I own a great deal of land in the Scofield-Beaver-Gordon Creek area, and it would benefit my operation to have a staging area at the site of the Gordon Creek Nos. 2, 7 and 8 Mines. I have had developing a staging area in this vicinity in mind for quite a while. I will require road access to the staging area and a fair amount of level ground for sheep pens and corrals. As you know, this area is rugged and often inaccessible. Leaving the pad for the No. 7 Mine and the access road to that pad will allow me to develop a staging area at this site. If the Division does not allow Mountain Coal to leave the pad and road, the area will once again be inaccessible, and could not be put to this higher and better use.
