Dear Mr. Haddock:

As we discussed on the phone late last week, the snow has finally melted off most of the bottom of the canyon at the Gordon Creek Mines where the channel repairs were completed last year. I was able to measure the areas of disturbances related to trucking in the filter material and rip rap for channel repairs. However, preparing a map illustrating the location of the repairs is a bit more problematic. We do not have suitable AutoCAD files of the maps requested to be updated in the Division's deficiency letter. We plan to use survey quality GPS equipment to locate the centerlines of the repair roads and the perimeter of larger disturbed areas. We will use that information to create a drawing of the repair areas using a Google-Earth or similar base map of the area. Our current plan is to conduct the survey this Thursday, April 28th, if the weather cooperates. After obtaining the survey information, we should be able to generate the map in two to three weeks. Because of time involved completing the survey and preparing the map, we unfortunately need to request another extension of time to address the Division's deficiencies related to our submittal.

We appreciate your consideration in this matter.
