RE: Permit Approval Stipulations UMC 817.113 (1) and UMC 817.114 (1), Gordon Creek No. 3 and 6 Mines, INA/007/017, Folder #2 and 4, Carbon County, Utah

UMC 817.113 (1)

This stipulation requested clarification of the timing of willow cuttings. The substitution of page 3-37 changed the planting time of willow cuttings to fall to coincide with the discussion on page 37b. It also resulted in the change of timing of all woody plantings to fall. This is acceptable in light of conversations with Dan Guy and Mel Coonrod that indicated that containerized plants rather than bare root plants would be used. The intended use of bare root material is described throughout the MRP.

This stipulation is met with the understanding that if woody materials are planted in fall, only containerized plants will be used.

UMC 817.114 (1)

This stipulation did not request a page substitution but was intended to clarify discrepancies between commitments on pages 3-36g and 3-37 of the MRP. Both pages 3-36g (this stipulation) and 3-37 (for stipulation discussed above) have been changed. This stipulation will be met when final reclamation is completed with at least 3000 lbs/acre of mulch.
