Dear Dr. Nielson:

On behalf of Sunedco Coal Company, we submit herewith Sunedco's application for approval, transfer, assignment or sale of permit right pursuant to UMC 788.18. Sunedco Coal Company has reached an agreement with Soldier Creek Coal Company to purchase all of the assets of Soldier Creek comprising the Soldier Canyon Mine and to assume operatorship duties of the mine.

In furtherance of that agreement, Soldier Creek Coal Company and Sunedco Coal Company have agreed upon the terms of a Sale and Purchase Agreement to be executed between the parties in the next few days. It is anticipated that the assignment of the affected federal coal leases U-50722 and SL-051279 will take place in the next week or ten days. Closing of this sale is anticipated in early September of this year.

A Mined Lands Reclamation Act Bond in the principal amount of \$522,592.00 has been procured by Sunedco Coal Company from Federal Insurance Company and will be submitted in support of the enclosed application upon final execution within the next few days. Notice of the proposed transfer has been published in the Price Sun Advocate and proof of that publication will be submitted to the Division as soon as it becomes available.

We would request that the Division favorably review the enclosed application and issue its approval of the transfer

of Permanent Program Permit UT-0023 at its earliest convenience.
