I received a call from Dave Spillman on April 30, 1985 notifying me that the bond has been signed and approved and was being Express mailed to the mine from California on April 30, 1985. Mr. Spillman must get the appropriate signatures, corporate seal and attach the land description Exhibit "A."

The bond should be here no later than May 6, 1985. In addition, an explanation of the amount of waste rock to be disposed of underground for the five-year permit term will be submitted at that time. Mark Humphrey, OSM, has given Dave Spillman a verbal okay to the bond extension.
