The abatement plans submitted by Soldier Creek Coal Company for Notice of Violation (NOV) N85-4-15-1 have been reviewed by the Division.

The plans have been found deficient and the company must submit the following information before the review can proceed and the plans approved:


1. Riprap design calculations must be submitted verifying that the stream channel will be adequately stabilized for velocities resulting from flow from the 25-year, 24-hour storm. The depth of flow utilizing the proposed riprap must also be supported by calculations.
2. Thirteen (13) copies of the complete set of plans should be submitted in a format allowing direct insertion into the appropriate section of the approved Mining and Reclamation Plans currently on file with the regulatory agencies.

These items must be submitted to the Division prior to September 20, 1985.
