The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Western Field Operations (WFO), has received the September 12, 1986, Soldier Creek Coal Company's submittal of an amendment to the approved mine reclamation plan of Utah permit No. ACT/007/018/86D for the Soldier Creek mine. OSMRE reviewed this submittal and has determined that it does not constitute a modification to the approved mining plan under 30 CFR 746.18. Based on the review of the submittal, OSMRE concurs with the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOGM's) decision to approve the submittal as indicated in DOGM's letter dated September 23, 1986, and the Federal permit UT-023-6, dated May 31, 1985, is revised accordingly.
