Dear Dr. Nielson:

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Western Field Operations (WFO), has received the Soldier Creek Coal Company's submittal of an amendment to the approved mine reclamation plan of Utah permit No. ACT/007/018 for the Soldier Canyon mine. The revision is for changing the list of corporate offices recorded in the approved permit. OSMRE reviewed this submittal and has determined that it does not constitute a modification to the approved mining plan under 30 CFR 746.18. Based on the review of the submittal, OSMRE concurs with the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOGM's) decision to approve the submittal as indicated in DOGM's letter dated March 6, 1987, and the Federal permit UT-023-6, dated May 31, 1985, is revised accordingly.
