RE: Establishment of Buffer Zone signs along Soldier Creek and designation of Buffer Zones in the MRP.

During the DSM Oversight Inspection conducted at your site on September 17, 1987 it was determined that Buffer Zone designations will be necessary to bring your plan and site into compliance with State regulations UMC 817.11 (e) and UMC 817.57 (b). Ten-Day Notice X87-02-006-010 was written as a result of this situation.

The need to post additional signs at any point located along your permitted area which is within 100 feet of Soldier Creek, was discussed during the inspection. We also discussed the necessity of amending your current MRP to include or designate these areas.

Specifically these areas include: 1. the sediment pond/topsoil storage area, 2. No. 2 exhaust fan and substation site, and 3. the fenceline which parallels Soldier Creek and separates the main yard facilities from the county road.

The Division asks that you make the above changes by Oct 31, 1987. Please contact myself or Susan Linner for any further questions.
