Re: Final Approval of As-built Construction Plans for Sediment Pond Embankment, NOV #N85-4-15-1, Soldier Creek Coal Company, Soldier Canyon Mine, ACT/U07/O18, Folder #4, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has completed the review of Soldier Creek Coal Company's (SCCC) plans received January 23, 1987 which were required as a condition to final approval of the abatement actions for the Notice of Violation referenced above. Mr. David Cline, Division Hydrologist, has reviewed the plans and prepared a technical memorandum which is attached to this letter.

The Division finds that SCCC has now adequately addressed all of the conditions which remained from our previous reviews and hereby issues final approval of the abatement plan requirement. In order to update all appropriate regulatory copies of SCCC's mining and reclamation plan (MRP) application, we must request that 12 complete copies of the final approved plans be directed to this office. The text must be numbered, dated and formatted to allow direct insertion into the current MRP application as updated replacement pages.

Please provide these additional copies by February 25, 1987. Thank you for your cooperation and patience in completing this permitting activity. Please call me or Dave Cline should you have any questions or concerns.
