Dear Daron:

As per our telephone conversation on April 15, 1991, Soldier Creek Coal Company (SC3) is seeking to amend the approved permit for repositioning of the power poles. The location of the power poles must be relocated to facilitate the Applicant's proposed road realignment.

The new locations are shown on Exhibit 4.2-6. As shown on the map, these new locations are within the Applicant's disturbed area boundary and on previously disturbed ground. Due to the portal development disturbance and R614-301-232.410, no topsoil is present or needs to be removed. The Applicant will ensure that the electric powerlines are designed and constructed to minimize electrocution hazards to raptors as per R614-301-358.510.

SC3 will show the final placement of the power poles in concurrence with the surface facilities and road relocation as-builts. The installers of the power poles are eagerly awaiting the Division's approval to proceed with the above mentioned work.
