Soldier Creek Coal Company (SC3) is requesting Division approval to remove its underground storage tanks between the maintenance shop and new shop, and replace them with above ground storage tanks. SC3 has already received approval from the Division of Environmental Health to proceed with removal of the underground storage tanks (see enclosed letter).
