Re: Pond Design Changes, Soldier Creek Coal Company, Soldier Canyon Mine,
ACT/007/018, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

On January 9, 1991 the Soldier Creek Coal Company (SC3) submitted a permit revision for road relocation and facilities expansion. Some deficiencies in pond design were identified in the review process. A revised submittal, received by the Division on June 10, 1991, included pond design changes. A copy of the submittal was mailed directly to Dave Ariotti, District Engineer for the Southeastern Utah District Department of Health, from SC3 as well as a copy of my review mailed from the Division office.

On July 26, 1991 Dave Ariotti informed me, by telephone, that no approval letter was necessary for the proposed pond design changes in this revision. Therefore, Soldier Creek Coal Company should commence with the proposed changes as soon as possible.
