The Division has conducted an Initial Completeness Review for publication on the road relocation and surface facilities expansion revision received on January 9, 1991. The information has been found to be adequate to determine the revision application package administratively complete. Please submit ten (10) additional copies of the revision package to the Division for distribution to other agencies. This should be done as soon as possible to allow for their comments prior to revision approval.

A technical review of the plan has been initiated. Technical deficiencies will be forwarded to you as individual reviews are completed. Issues raised will need to be resolved prior to revision approval.

At this time the applicant should publish a Notice of Application for Permit Revision as required by R614-300-121. The affidavit of publication should be sent to the Division as soon as it is available. The Division will notify all other interested agencies and allow for their comment prior to making a final decision to approve or disapprove the revision application.
