4d. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: WATER MONITORING

A meeting was held September 18, 1997 at the Salt Lake DOGM office to discuss some problems which exist with the water monitoring regime for the Soldier Canyon Mine. The problems include removal of monitoring points, and revisions to some maps and tables. The TA for the site will also need to be revised. As of 10/22/97, Mr. Spillman informed me that due to an unusually heavy workload, he has been unable to address these revisions. I have made mention of this to Mr. Keith Zobell of Mayo and Associates (the firm conducting the water monitoring for the site) who indicated that he will continue to monitor all sites that are still necessary until the revisions can be compiled and approved by the DOGM.


8. NONCOAL WASTE

It has been suggested to the permittee that two areas at the site be looked at to determine if some disposal of old mining components can be accomplished. These areas include 1) the R.E.I. storage area adjacent to the mine site sediment pond, and 2) the storage area WNW of the operating #1 mine fan. Mr. Nye was not aware of any possibility for the future utilization of R.E.I. coal degasification techniques, but indicated that he would check with upper management concerning same.
