Dear Mr. Braxton,

When reviewing the permit renewal for Soldier Canyon Mine (C/007/018), we noticed there were differences between the legal description which appeared in the newspaper and the one typed into the permit. Upon examination we have discovered there are several correct ways to describe the same lands, however we still have concerns with the descriptions of the following sections. Section 3 is not a full section and is divided into lots not quarters, and the change listed below correctly reflects the lands in Section 3. The difference is Sections 10 and 24 are most likely just typing errors. Although the description of Section 19 is correct, by adding the W1/2 it becomes more descriptive of the area.

Township 13 S., Range 11 E., Salt Lake Base and Meridian

Section 3: ~~SW1/4, W1/2SE1/4~~ - Lots 5, 6, 7
 Section 10: N1/2, E1/2 ~~SE1/4~~ SE1/2, NW1/4 SE1/4, NW1/4 SW1/4
 Section 24: N1/2 N1/2 NW1/4, Portion of ~~SE1/4~~E1/2 SE1/4 SE1/4

Township 13 S., Range 12 E., Salt Lake Base and Meridian

Section 19: Portion of the ~~W1/2~~ SW1/4 SW1/4

We would appreciate your assistance in making these revisions to the legal description.

In addition, the location map shows the permit boundary extending into Township 12S Range 12E and as you can see from the legal description, our permitted area does not extend into that township and range.

Upon receiving the copies of the corrected pages (1 and 2) of the permit, we will return the signed permit document. Thank you again for your assistance.
