The last Division inspection of the site was conducted on 11/14/2017 during an OSM partial oversight. 2018 inspection reports reference the topsoil pile sign, but not the condition of the site. The Division will make a site visit during 2nd Quarter 2018.

On July 3, 2019, P. Burton evaluated the topsoil stockpile, along with mine representatives, and that evaluation is described in Inspection Report # 6461. The report was sent to the operator and to the file on July 9, 2019.
