The Division's July 3, 2019 Inspection report #6461 states:

" In the winter of 2019, Carbon County received record snowfall and had a wet spring. The topsoil stockpiles have 100% cover reflecting the moist conditions. The cover is weedy forbs and grasses. A dominant forb is *Sisymbrium altissimum* (tall tumble mustard). *Erodium cicutarium* (storksbill) was also observed on the site. There are no noxious weeds on the stockpiles."

A site visit in should be conducted in 2020. 5/28/2020, PB.
