Tower Resources 1982 exploration plan is approved subject to the enclosed stipulations of the Bureau of Land Management and the Minerals Management Service. In reviewing the plan, we have determined that the proposal is not a major action that would significantly effect the environment. As noted in your phone conversation today with Stephen Falk of our staff, road construction to the drill sites will be approved with a BLM right-of-way which is expected to be granted next week.

Our office has modified the "Stipulations Covering Surface Drilling Programs" with regards to drill hole plugging. The enclosed stipulations of the Minerals Management Service is current showing the new requirements. Please take careful note of these new stipulations.
