Dear Mr. Quigley:

In trying to conclude the review process for the conditionally approved second five-year permit, the Division has reviewed the September 22 and October 8, 1987 Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) submittals. These were submitted in response to an August 19, 1987 Division review letter which required that "the enclosed deficiencies (be) addressed completely...within thirty days of receipt of that review." As you will recall, the original requirement to submit a new reformatted MRP was a condition to the renewal of the five-year permanent program permit of March 3, 1987. The condition requires submittal of a comprehensive, well-organized, and current MRP; and is consistent with all first-round permit renewals conducted by the Division to date. Normally this process is accomplished in the Mid-Permit Term Review, but as you are aware, a Mid-Permit Term Review was not conducted on the Centennial Project during the first permit term.

To date, Andalex Resources, Inc. (ARI) has made three MRP submittals since the conditional permit approval of March 3, 1987. Despite this, many of the Division's initial concerns still have not been answered and the Division still does not have on file a plan which can be called well-organized or comprehensive (complete). In light of the failure to provide a complete plan in response to the August 19 review letter, enforcement action will be taken at this time. Attached to this letter is a Notice of Violation (NOV) outlining what ARI must do to come into compliance with the permit condition.


