April 30, 1987 will extend the usual time period for annual reports one month, and is acceptable to the Division for your 1986 Annual Report to be submitted to this office.



On a recent inspection of Andalex's mine by Holland Shepherd of the UDOGM staff, it was brought to my attention that an annual report was to be submitted to the Division by March 31 of this year, reflecting the pertinent information on the 1986 calendar year.
