
Dear Ms Linner:

In response to your letter concerning the project referenced above, the staff of the Utah State Historic Preservation Office has reviewed the revision to the approved mine plan for the Aberdeen Mine. From our review of this revision, it appears that there will be some modifications to surface facilities. There is also a statement to the effect that there will be no new surface disturbances.

Our records indicate that part of the Aberdeen Mine has been surveyed for cultural resources. However, the survey that we have been able to reference apparently did not extend into Section 7, where some new facilities will be located. We note that historic mining sites were found in Section 18. It appears that some clarification as to the exact proposals of this revision, as well as information concerning any known cultural resource surveys, would be beneficial.
