Re: Sediment Pond B Material

Dear Mr. Leatherwood:

I am enclosing for your review a copy of the plan and profile for Sediment Catch Basin "B". Taking measurements from this plate indicates there are 140 cubic yards of material currently being stored. This is a conservative estimate based on only one profile through the pond, at its deepest point.

I believe this is all the information which has been requested by your office.

It is my understanding that this material can now be used as fill where it is not a growth medium, or it may be hauled to an unpermitted disposal site such as the Carbon County Landfill since it is non-toxic and non-acid forming and is a non-coal waste (Nov. 25, 1987 Lowell Braxton memo).

Please advise me if this is an accurate interpretation of our discussions. Thank You.
