1. Permits

The Division has completed the technical analysis and decision document for the addition of new leases to the permit. The proposal has been approved by the Division with attached stipulations. The approval will be sent from the Division offices early next week (week of October 10 through 14, 1988).

4b. Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

At the time of the inspection, there was no flow occurring in any of the onsite diversions. The diversions were all stable with very little evidence of downcutting or deposition observed. The diversion designs are scheduled for a complete review by Division staff in the near future. The diversions located at the office facilities area were inspected. The diversions are largely vegetated on low slope areas and appear to be adequately located to divert undisturbed drainage from the disturbed area. A small reach to the northwest of the office did not have a current diversion installed. The drainage from this area should be included in all future calculations for sediment pond runoff volume or a diversion should be proposed for this area. The Division is awaiting response to our review of the newly proposed sediment pond (pond D). This issue will be addressed during that technical review.

4e. Hydrologic Balance: Surface and Ground Water Monitoring


A review of the Division's water monitoring files indicates that the last sample report received was for the fourth quarter of 1987. No sample reports have been received in 1988. The operator has failed to follow the requirements of UMC 817.52 for sample reports for the first and second quarters of 1988. The operator (Mike Glasson) was contacted via telephone regarding this matter. He responded that to his knowledge no reports were submitted to DOGM. Notice of Violation N88-15-2-1 was issued from the Division offices on October 13, 1988. The abatement measures were to submit water quality sample results and NPDES reports from December, 1987 to October, 1988. Reports were received 10/11/88. NOV was terminated on day issued.
