Synopsis

Andalex Resources, Inc. has requested to modify the mining sequence in their Apex (in the Lower Sunnyside Seam), and Aberdeen (in the Aberdeen seam, also known as the Castlegate A Seam) Mines. These changes would align the above-mentioned mines with the mining sequence of the Pinnacle Mine. The amendment also requests leaving some pillars in the Apex Mine to give even support to the competent sandstone roof.

These changes have been approved by the Bureau of Land Management, Moab District, Utah, and are consistent with mining practices.

Recommendations
