Dear Mr. Kunzter:

The Bureau of Land Management has received a right-of-way application from Andalex Resources for portal and associated surface facilities for the Aberdine Mine in the left fork of Deadman Canyon: T. 13 S., R. 11 E., Sections 12 and 13. The proposed facilities are located within a .5-mile buffer zone for a golden eagle nest documented as active in June 1988.

A meeting has been scheduled for January 31, 1989 at 10 a.m. in the BLM, Price River Resource Area office to assess and discuss potential impacts to the golden eagle and identify options for the development of the Aberdine Mine. A field trip (optional) is planned for 11 a.m., weather permitting.

The proposed development site is located approximately one mile up the left fork of Deadman Canyon and is accessible by cross-country skis or snowshoes.
