Dear ^{Lowell} Mr. Braxton:

As a follow up to our conversation on August 29, 1990 this letter will confirm that Andalex Resources Inc., will need to uncover an old mine working in the Aberdeen coal seam located in the Star Point Fork of Deadman Canyon. It is imperative that Andalex explore and map the extremities of these workings in order to insure safety in the existing Aberdeen Mine which must go around the old works.

As you are aware, the surface area associated with these workings (known as Blue Flame #1) is scheduled for reclamation under your AML program during this construction season. As such, Andalex will need to create no new disturbance what so ever. The work involves removing a shallow amount of fill with a small backhoe which has "sluffed" over the portal area. We will require no new roads or trails. Only enough material required for access will be removed. Once the survey work is complete, Andalex will replace the fill material back over the portal area, thereby returning the area to its current or "as is" condition. This will constitute the extent of Andalex's work in this area. Andalex will not reseed any of the replacement fill as this will become a part of the Division's reclamation work later this year.

Andalex will notify the Division upon completion of this project.

We appreciate the Division's prompt response to this necessary work.
