re: ACT 007/019 Surface Drainage Modification

Dear Mr. Haddock:

This letter is to request a small modification to our surface drainage plan. As you are aware, Andalex has an 18" diameter culvert located immediately behind our bathhouse water tanks. The intent of the culvert was to divert a small amount of runoff water from the substation road away from the Pinnacle Mine coal stockpile pad.

We are requesting the removal of this culvert for two reasons. First, the amount of runoff which occurs from this area is negligible, and regardless of the presence of the culvert, that water cannot leave the site without first entering a sediment pond. The water can be diverted using an earth berm. Secondly, this particular culvert is a constant maintenance problem. It is situated such that wind blown coal fines from the nearby stockpile are constantly blocking the inlet. At times, the inlet is completely buried. It will be our plan to maintain a berm around that corner so that any runoff would still proceed by the stockpile pad and into that culvert. From there it would empty into Catch Basin B, the same location where the runoff is currently diverted.

Please advise me at your earliest convenience if we can proceed with this work.
