

NOTICE OF PERMIT APPROVAL

To Whom It May Concern:
Pursuant to the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act (Utah Code Annotated 1953, Section 40-10-1 et seq), and the "Regulations Pertaining to Surface Effects of Underground Coal Mining Activities" (Final Rules of the Utah Board of Oil, Gas and Mining), the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining has issued a revised permit including their Graves Lease Addition UTU-66060 to Andalex Resources, Inc., for its permit application No. ACT/007/019.
