Re: Denial, Minor Modification to Riprap Design, Andalex Resources Inc., Centennial Project, ACT/007/019-92D, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has reviewed your minor modification which proposes to remove riprap protection from diversion UD-2 and has determined that your submittal is not adequate for approval. Your modification is hereby denied.

Problems with your submittal hinge around failing to provide adequate design information which would demonstrate compliance with R645-301-742.300. Although Observation of the diversion for a number of years may provide useful information, it is not considered adequate design information required by the regulations.

Removal of the riprap protection may still be an alternative and the Division would be happy to review additional submittals as long as compliance is demonstrated by using appropriate design criteria. If you have any questions, please call me or Rick Summers, Reclamation Hydrologist.
