Dear Mr. Glasson:

The Division has completed a review of your application to add the Aberdeen Seam into lease UTU-69600 in your permit area. At this time, there are a few remaining items that need to be completed before we can consider your plan ready for approval. They are listed below.

1. Andalex must commit to mitigate all subsidence related damage to renewable resources. Those renewable resources include, but are not limited to, water, grazing and wildlife habitat, especially raptor nests.
2. Andalex must supply the Division with additional information on raptor nesting sites in the subsidence area. The information must include the location of the nest sites, and possible impacts caused by subsidence. Specific plans will need to be submitted for any identified impacts.
3. Andalex must provide enough information so that a determination on maximum use and conservation of the coal resource can be made. (It is suggested that a copy of the Resource Recovery and Protection Plan be submitted for insertion to the Mining and Reclamation Plan.)
4. Page 83 of the application must be corrected to include the Aberdeen Seam and the Aberdeen Mine.
