Dear Mr. Glasson:

The amendment received on November 16, 1993 with subsequent submittals received on January 24th and March 4th, 1994, regarding the above noted permitting action was reviewed and found to be adequate for approval by the Division's technical staff.

The Division hereby approves the above referenced amendment with the following conditions. 1) Andalex must clearly mark the location of the rock check dam for UD-4 and UD-5 on Plate 8, as states on page 160-A. These should be labeled on the map or in the map key as rock check dams. 2) Andalex must provide calculation of the time of concentration and peak flows for all disturbed area diversions. Peak discharges for all disturbed area diversions should be calculated with their proper curve numbers. Diversions that are fed by both disturbed and undisturbed area should use a prorated curve number based on the percent area disturbed versed undisturbed. 3) Andalex must submit 8 additional copies of the complete amendment including the revised Plate 11 by no later than April 7, 1994 for distribution to other agencies.
