4A. DIVERSIONS -

The diversions were cleaned out since the last inspection. The diversions were spot-checked with no problems being noted. The ditches are functioning as designed in the Mining and Reclamation Plan.

4B. SEDIMENT PONDS -

The sediment ponds contained little or no water and, therefore, were not discharging during the inspection. There were no signs of hazardous conditions existing during the inspection.

4C. OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES -

The straw bales located at the topsoil pile by the road leading to the bathhouse will need some replacement unless the permittee decides to submit an amendment for an SAE exemption. The vegetation is plentiful and would most likely meet Division requirements.

18. OTHER SUPPORT FACILITIES -

The new fan installation was inspected with all environmental controls installed and were functioning as designed in the Mining and Reclamation Plan.
