



I believe all questions should be answered either by this submittal or through previous submittals which I have explained in this letter.

R645-301-112: Plates 2, 3 and 4 show the boundary of the proposed permit area and were previously submitted.

R645-301-114: The new page 21-A now contains a description of the right of entry granted to ANDALEX by the BLM. Page 20 already contained a statement regarding lack of pending litigation for all leases.

R645-301-521: The acreage information on the new page 21-A has been corrected

R645-301-121.200: The page numbers which were misplaced have been corrected.

R645-301-521: Page 23 has been corrected to include the general location of BLM Right of Way UTU-64158.

R645-301-411.140: The SHPO has been contacted and we hope to send the UDOGM a finding of no effect very shortly.

R-645-301-521: Enclosed are updated versions of Plates 26, 27 and 28 which now show the IBC boundary as well as the Left Fork Fan right of way (ROW on the Plates).
