Dear Mr. Muck:

The Division has received an application to increase the permit area of the Centennial Mine by 160 acres. This increase is considered an Incidental Boundary Change and is within Federal Lease U-66060, which was modified in 1994 by the Bureau of Land Management. The enclosed map provides a description of the area to be added.

Mining in this area will be done as an extension of the existing underground mine. No new surface disturbance is planned. It is the Division's opinion that no wildlife species will be impacted by this action, however we will need your concurrence for federal mine plan approval. Andalex has informed us that they need to mine in this area soon otherwise they may have to bypass coal reserves. Could you please provide your comments as quickly as possible?



