**1. PERMIT -**

Currently there are no new permitting actions taking place between the PFO and Andalex.

**3. TOPSOIL -**

The topsoil piles have started to turn green with vegetation. Several of these piles use vegetation for topsoil erosion control.

**4a. DIVERSIONS -**

The diversions were spot-checked and no water flow was noticed.

The diversions appear to be functioning as designed.

**4b. SEDIMENT PONDS -**

The sediment ponds were inspected and no hazardous conditions were noticed.

The sediment ponds did contain small amounts of water but will not likely discharge in the near future.

**4c. OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES -**

The permittee still uses straw bales as sediment control in several areas but may apply for exemptions to demonstrate that straw bales are no longer needed.
