I'm working on a proposal to add a new coal lease area to the Centennial Mine. There's would be no surface disturbance except possible subsidence, but the mine has never detected any subsidence. Mining would be under about 2600 feet of cover. The surface is the top of a plateau in the Book Cliffs--relatively flat with sagebrush, grass, and aspen.
