The Division received your application for a reduction in the permit area because of a proposed gas well and pipeline on August 13, 2008. We are returning it because:

- The amendment did not include a copy of all of the maps that show the permit area. Any time the permit area changes all the maps that show the permit boundary must be updated.
- The amendment did not include information that the area is stable. You must submit information that subsidence in the area has stabilized.

While not a deficiency the Division determined that we need a map of the permit area that shows the location of the disturbed area boundaries. Specifically a map that shows the location of the main mine facilities and the degas wells.

Copies that were submitted to our office are enclosed. We look forward to receiving your revised plans.
