Dave Shaver called in today to update the Division that the thistle removal is still ongoing. Upon the last inspection on 8/25/2011, it was determined that thistle was still present at gas vent well GVH-6 and additional mitigation was needed. Dave indicated that the thistle was being removed from the area.

Representatives from Scamp construction and Andalex Resources were on-site on August 26, 2011 to evaluate all well pad sites for contemporaneous reclamation. It was agreed that all well sites can be reduced to a minimal disturbance footprint to allow for as much contemporaneous reclamation as possible.

Oso Energy (Oso) representatives were also present. It was agreed that several inactive solar panel structures that are the property of Oso will be removed as part of the reclamation activities. There are four active solar panel structures that will be relocated at the completion of reclamation work. Culverts that house valves that tap into Oso's main pipeline are present on each "pad-only" sites: GVH-15, GVH-16, and GVH=17. Oso has agreed to pull culverts and cap off valves since wells were never developed on these pads and therefore the Oso structures have been determined to not have any use.

NOV #10090 has been modified to include a violation for failure to follow contemporaneous reclamation requirements that are outlined in Appendix X of the approved MRP (Sections 341 and 352 of Appendix X). The abatement date of September 29, 2011 still stands.

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
