The current DOGM permit was issued effective 01/04/2007 and expires on 01/05/2012.

- UPDES permit UT0025674 effective 12/01/2006 and expires midnight 11/30/2011.
- Air Quality permit DAQE-997-96, issued October 25, 1996.
- SPCC Plan dated 11/2/2009.

2. Signs and Markers

The mine identification sign is in place and contains the required information.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The undisturbed culvert inlet adjacent to the oil storage shed was 100% plugged during the inspection. Spoke with Chan Snyder at the mine shop. Chan opened up the inlet so that it is functional. A large volume of sediment and leaves still remains behind the inlet and has a high potential of plugging the inlet in the near future. Dave Shaver is off on medical leave. Called Dana Marrelli and apprised her of the situation. Dana indicated that she would contact Dale Davis, who is responsible for all surface maintenance of the varied mine sites, and inform him of the needed maintenance.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The second quarter 2011 pond inspections were done on June 17, 2011.

4.e Hydrologic Balance: Effluent Limitations

Reviewed the July and August 2011 discharge reports. No discharges took place in during either month.

16.a Roads: Construction, Maintenance, Surfacing

The road leading to the oil storage shed still has an erosional cut across it that needs to be filled.

20. Air Quality Permit

The air quality permit DAQE-997-96 referenced above was issued on October 25, 1996 and remains in effect.
