I am wondering if you observed anything out of the ordinary while doing your sampling (i.e. orange discoloration)? Was the well purged of at least three volumes of water before you took the sample? We have seen high iron levels in this well in the past I believe it was attributed to the cable rusting, but it seems we have not been able to pin down the source of this iron might be from.
